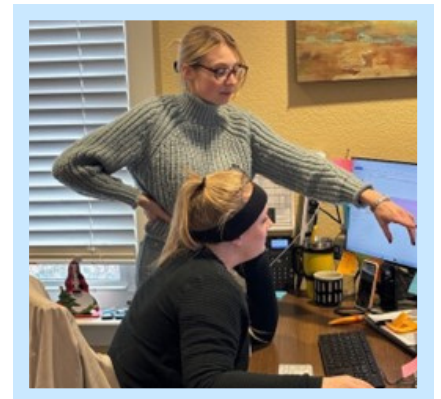

HOLIDAY TRASH SCHEDULE

Due to the President's Day Holiday on Monday, February 17, 2025, trash and recycling will be collected on **Tuesday, February 18, 2025 for the following neighborhoods:**

COMMUNITY REMINDERS

Please be mindful of your noise level during quiet hours and let your neighbors know if you are planning a noisy event. Quiet hours are observed between the hours of 10:00p.m and 6:00a.m.

Refuse Bins must be at the curb before 7am on your scheduled pick-up day, unless otherwise instructed by the community team. If desired, you may place your refuse bins at curbside after 6pm the day before collection day. The bins must be returned to proper storage by 8pm on the day of collection. Proper storage is considered along the side of the house, in the garage, in a designated storage area, or as otherwise instructed by your community team.

MAINTENANCE TIPS

Test smoke alarms monthly.

Ensure your Heating and Air Conditioning (HVAC) unit continues to function at peak level by changing your air filter each month. Filters are available at your community centers.

SAFETY TIPS

Space Heaters are the second leading cause of home fires.

Follow these tips for Safe usage:

Keep all flammables, like paper, clothing, bedding, drapes or rugs, at least 3 feet from a space heater, stove or fireplace.

Never leave portable heaters and fireplaces unattended; turn off heaters and make sure fireplace embers are extinguished before leaving the room.

Place your space heat on a level, nonflammable surface, like ceramic tile, not on a rug or carpet.


Keep children and pets away from space heaters

When buying a space heater, look for models that shut off automatically if the heater falls over.


If you have already contacted our local Management and Housing office team and are not satisfied with the outcome, or if you have words of praise to share, we encourage you to reach out to our senior management.
