COMMUNITY REMINDERS

To maintain a pleasant living environment for all residents, we kindly request your cooperation in adhering to the following community guidelines:

- **Pet Waste:** Please promptly pick up after your pet and dispose of it in designated areas.
- **Property Maintenance:** Keep your immediate surroundings and common areas free of debris and clutter. Toys should be brought indoors when not in use and never left in shared spaces.
- **Home Modifications:** Any modifications to your home, including the installation of security cameras, require prior, written approval from the community center. When installing items (cameras/decorations) to your home, please avoid drilling, screwing, or nailing into the exterior.
- **Parking Restrictions:** Please refrain from parking on the grass. To ensure you and your family's safety, please park with the flow of traffic.

These updates are designed to improve our community environment and create a positive living experience for all residents. These guidelines are immediately effective for all new families who have joined us since October 23, 2024, and will become effective for families who lived with us prior to that date upon signing a new lease agreement. SAFETY TIPS

Daylight Saving Time 2025 – March 9, 2025


Daylight saving time, also referred to as daylight savings time, is the practice of advancing clocks to make better use of the longer daylight available during summer so that darkness falls at a later clock time.

- The first rule of daylight saving time safety should be installing fresh batteries in all smoke and carbon monoxide detectors before changing your clocks.
- Try to get at least seven hours of sleep before and after the time change
- Shift bedtimes and wake-up times by 15 to 20 minutes earlier a few nights before the time change
- Go outside for some early morning sunlight the week following the time change to help your internal clock shift to the new time
- Set your clocks an hour ahead before going to bed Saturday night and try to get to sleep at your normal bedtime.
- Check the time on all appliances and electronic devices. Even though many devices switch to daylight saving time automatically, appliances like the oven and microwave may still need to be changed manually.
- Don't forget to test all smoke and carbon monoxide alarms at least twice a year.
- To check the operation of a smoke detector, simply press and hold the alarm's "test" button. If it beeps or rings loudly, it's working properly. 2. Ensure your Heating and Air Conditioning (HVAC) unit continues to function at peak level by changing your air filter each month. Filters are available at your community centers.
